



## MLA Works Cited for Journals, Magazines, and Newspapers (Print and Online)

This handout gives you sample Works Cited entries for both online and print magazines, journals, and newspapers. For online works, the location, in order of preference, is 1) the DOI, 2) permalink, or 3) the URL (http://address). At the end of your Works Cited entry, provide one of the following:

1. Provide a DOI (digital object identifier) if possible. This number will begin with https://doi . . .
2. If there is no DOI, search for a permalink (NOT the web address at the top of screen). Look at the screen specifically for the word **Permalink**.
3. If there is no DOI nor permalink, supply the URL for the specific source.

### A Note about Authors

Use this guide to determine how many authors' names to include in your Works Cited entry.

Number of Authors	Works Cited Entry Beginning
No Named Author	"Title of Article." >>> Alphabetize by the first major word of the title not counting A, An, and The.
Article with One Author	Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial.
Article with Two Authors	Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial., and First Name Middle Initial. Last Name of second author.
Article with Three or More Authors	Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial., et al. >>> et al. = and others
Article with Group Author	Name of Group Author.

### A Note about Page Numbers

If an article is on consecutive pages, write the page numbers like this: pp. 16-18. If the article is on non-consecutive pages, write just the starting page number with a plus sign like this: pp. 16+.

### *Italicizing a Title versus "Enclosing Title in Quotation Marks"*

If your source is a smaller work out of a larger work (an essay, article or chapter), enclose the title in "quotation marks." If your source is the entire work (a journal, magazine, or newspaper) *italicize the title*.

Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial. "Article Title." <i>Publication Title</i> , volume number, issue number, publication date, page range. <i>Name of Database</i> , DOI, permalink, or URL.

### Article with Two Authors

Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial., and Author's First Name Middle Initial. Last Name. "Article Title." *Publication Title*, volume number, issue number, publication date, page range. *Name of Database*. DOI, permalink, or URL.

### Article with Three or More Authors

Author's Last Name, First Name Middle Initial., et al. "Article Title." *Publication Title*, volume number, issue number, publication date, page range. *Name of Database*. DOI, permalink, or URL. **Note: "et al." is Latin for "and others."**

Name of Group. "Article Title." *Publication Title*, volume number, issue number, publication date, page range. *Name of Database*. DOI, permalink, or URL.
